Grade

5: We are going to start a lesson on color We will make a butterfly together and then students will make some on their own. The next week we will learn more about color schemes, that they can use to paint their butterfly.

4: We will continue work with an “Element of art” the line, more specifically curvy lines. We will draw some circles and draw curved lines around the circles as stripes. Students will have a challenge making the stripes even and not having any of the lines touch.

3: We will start work with lines drawing it as stripes and then have it looping, weaving, and crisscrossing your paper it is a significant challenge. This is the focus of our work this week.

2: This week we will start drawing shapes. The students are going to draw overlapping shapes and color them solid making a silhouette. This is an introduction to silhouettes leading up to a more challenging silhouette project.

1: We will draw an owl. It is a good place to start the year. There are a variety of lines and shapes needed to draw an owl and that is our focus this week.

Kg: We will draw 3 birds with crayons. Then we will paint the birds with watercolor paint.
